EMPLOYEES ENJOY A CHEAPER COMMUTE WITH THE TRIP TO WORK PROGRAM

Employees working in the Southeast Urban Corridor can save 50% off the regular price of an RTD pass by participating in the Trip to Work program. This program offers employees discounted passes available for use on RTD buses, light rail, or call-n-ride.

Rising gas prices and the trend toward more eco-friendly lifestyles have led many consumers to seek out alternatives to their daily commute. The South I-25 Urban Corridor Transportation Management Association partnered with RTD to create the Trip to Work program as a way of providing employees with a low-cost alternative to driving to work.

Since being introduced in February 2008, the Trip to Work program has become hugely successful, with over 3,000 passes sold to date. Additionally, the demand for passes has steadily increased each month by approximately 250 passes. This demand is expected to continue growing as gas prices reach record highs.

The South I-25 Urban Corridor TMA is a coalition of local governments, Arapahoe County, Douglas County, City of Greenwood Village, City of Centennial, City of Lone Tree, the Southeast Public Improvement Metropolitan District (SPIMD), and the business community, represented by the Southeast Business Partnership (SEBP), who joined together to provide political and economic resources to identify and meet the corridor's transportation needs.
